Negotiations Update

Teacher/Occasional Teacher Central Table Negotiations Update

After three consecutive days of talks at the Teacher/Occasional Teacher central bargaining table, negotiations between OSSTF/FEESO, the Ontario Public School Boards Association and the Government of Ontario have failed to produce an agreement.

The OPSBA/Government management team has continued to place major road blocks in the way of any agreement that would be acceptable to OSSTF/FEESO.

At this point talks have been suspended and no further dates have been scheduled. OSSTF/FEESO remains willing and available to go back to the table at any time to engage in meaningful negotiations.

Teacher/Occasional Teacher Local Negotiations Update

Teacher/Occasional Teacher negotiations between OSSTF/FEESO District 19, Peel, and the Peel Region School Board have failed to result in an agreement. Consequently, members of the teacher and occasional teacher bargaining units in Peel have begun a full withdrawal of services as of this morning, May 4.
